## **RULES OF CONDUCT TO BE MAINTAINED DURING REMOTE EXAMS**

During the exam, the student pledges:

- 1) not to make use of any external aid or support, whether it be paper or electronic (e.g. manuals, lecture notes, personal notes, books, publications, mobile phones, handheld computers or other electronic devices), unless expressly authorized by the examiner;
- 2) not to copy or look at the exams of other candidates;
- 3) not to contact or try to contact other people in any way;
- 4) to keep his/her microphone off during the oral or written examination of another student, unless otherwise requested by the examiner.

Moreover, the student:

- a) will use the chat function or other method indicated by the examiner to ask questions during the exam;
- b) in the case of written exams, will remain connected for as long as strictly necessary for the duration of his/her exam, unless otherwise instructed by the examiner;
- c) will submit the exam according to the methods decided on by the examiner.

### Penalties

Any violation of the rules defined above, or of any other provisions indicated by the examiner entails the cancellation of the exam and the *ex officio* sending of a report to the President of the degree program in order to evaluate the imposition of the disciplinary sanctions provided by the university's Student Regulations.
